Background

Surf Life Saving NSW (SLSNSW) is pleased to announce the inception of five (5) Surf Sport Development Academies to bolster the competitive and pathway experience for athletes aged 15 -17. Supported by six (6) Regional Academies of Sport, the program will provide recognition, motivation, and performance services to selected talented athletes.

Program

The Regional Academies of Sport Inc. (RASi) will help deliver an effective High Performance development program that provides selected athletes exposure to sports science, personal development and education services including:

1. Athlete education:

Exercise Physiology Injury Prevention and Management Nutrition Social Media & Cyber Safety Sports Psychology

2. Strength & conditioning

Face to Face Training Sessions (1 per week) **Initial Testing & Screening** Follow up Education & Programming

The program will commence in late October 2023.

Surf Sport specific skill acquisition and development will be delivered by SLSNSW appointed coaches (ad – hoc) from within the region-based academy structure. Applications are concurrently open for SLSNSW Academy coaches and management.

Selection

The initial intake of athletes will include 74 athletes, with an additional 46 athletes added to the program in the following year. Athletes will be selected by the SLSNSW Selection Panel. Athletes must be current financial members and be 15 years of age as of 30 September 2023, to be eligible.

Levy

To subsidise the academy services, athletes will be charged a \$500.00 per annum levy. Activities beyond the RASi service stream will be ad – hoc and will incur additional costs.

How to Nominate

- All nominating members are asked to familiarise themselves with the <u>SLSNSW Selection</u>
 <u>Policy</u> and the SLSNSW Athlete & Management Agreement. All athletes will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.
- Complete the <u>Online Nomination Form</u> by 13 October 2023.
- All nominees must be current financial members and proficient with their relevant awards.
 All nominations must be endorsed by Club representatives.
- After the close of nominations, Branch will be sent all nominations from within their Branch.
 Branch will then be required to provide endorsement for nominations to SLSNSW within 48
 hours. Individuals are not required to seek a letter from Branch prior to nomination. If
 Branch does not endorse the nomination, it will be the responsibility of the Branch to
 communicate this to the members.
