Competition Summary

- U8 Competitors DON'T NEED A LIVE HEATS BAND.
- Wristbands can be purchased to those who need one and will be available for purchase for
- \$5.00 via EFTPOS or CASH (exact money only) for those who require one.
- Wristbands from prior events or season can be re-used for the same competitor.
- Marshalling Report Times:
 - SATURDAY
 - All Age Board Relay 7:15am Marshall - 7:30am start.
 - Main Carnival Marshall 7:45am - 8:00am start.
 - Water Safety must be checked in at their allocated area by – 7:15am
 - SUNDAY
 - R and R - 6:45am report time for 7:00am START.
 - 1km Beach Runs – Marshall 7:30am - 7:40am start.
 - All Age Sprint Relay – Marshall 8:00am - 8:15am start.
 - Main Carnival Marshall – Marshall 8:30am - 8:45am start.
 - Officials must be checked in at their allocated area by – 7:15am for long distance runs 7:30 for all other events
- Newcastle Permanent Pink Rash vests must be worn by all competitors – Limited quantities of these will be available to purchase on the day Singlet \$15 Long Sleeved \$20
- All events are subject to change at the discretion of the referee

Live Heats

Live Heats will be in operation at this carnival. Key Live heats information is listed below:

- All competitors will need a wristband for competition. Wristbands from last season are still usable.
- Wristbands can be purchased for \$5.00 on the morning between 7:30 & 8:30. Purchase can be made via EFTPOS
- NO WRISTBAND = NO COMPETITION.
- The live heats desk will be open from 6:30-8:00 am. There is no need to check in if you have a wristband already.
- Wristbands are to be worn for the duration of the event.
- Team changes can be done by club team managers via the 'Live Heats Team Manager Portal'

Officials, Water Safety & Parent Helpers

To sign on at a carnival, Officials and Water Safety will now go straight to the Officials briefing at 7.30 on the beach and then report to their designated area (communicated in the WhatsApp group the day before) and sign on with the Sectional Referee. - Officials are allowed to co-ordinate split shifts or a swap in areas during a carnival providing all members have signed in, are qualified and it does not cause disruption to the carnival. If you are swapping with someone else, please make sure your Sectional Referee is made aware
- Failure to fulfil the club's quota of Officials and Water Safety will result the club unable to compete until positions are filled
- Where a club has not filled their quota the role in an area prior to the cut-off date, the role will be assigned to the club.
- **ALL EVENTS U9 upwards must use Live Heats**
- After a carnival, don't forget to log into your Members Portal to Log your official hours

Ratios

As per Circular 1634 clubs are required to provide Water Safety and Officials/Parent Helpers.

Water Safety and official/parent helper ratios are calculated on entry numbers per club. The U8 entries are taken out of this calculation.

Parent Helpers are to act as 'officials' during the carnival in suitable roles e.g. Live Heats Operator,

Marshall, Flag Placer etc Clubs not fulfilling their quota are at risk of having competitors removed from the carnival.
